

Grant applications to the Community Impact Fund are divided into two streams. An organization can apply once to each stream.

Community Enrichment Grants

The purpose of the Community Enrichment stream is to support community initiatives in the Yellowknife, Dettah and N'Dilo areas. Organizations may apply for grants between \$1,000 and \$25,000 that complement their new and/or existing programs and initiatives.

Eligible costs: Capital projects incl. renovations, wages, purchase of equipment or materials, administration costs up to 15% of proposed budget


Organizational Capacity Grants

The purpose of the Organizational Capacity stream is to support organizational needs and to help strengthen the non-profit and charitable sector in Yellowknife.

Organizations may apply for up to \$5,000 to support professional training or learning opportunities for staff or board members.
