## Description

Fred Carmichael has been an influential leader who has committed himself to the economic growth and development of Indigenous peoples in Canada's North.

Fred Carmichael grew up on the land near Aklavik. When he was a young boy, he saw his first airplane, he fell in love with the dream of flying. He worked hard to purchase his own plane and eventually became the first Indigenous person in the Northwest Territories to earn his wings as a commercial pilot.

When Fred Carmichael left the Gwich'in Tribal Council in 2008, twenty-seven businesses from across Canada recognized his efforts to provide northerners with northern training for northern jobs by contributing to this award fund. Through this award, Fred wishes to encourage students to persevere through difficulties, as he had to do, in order to follow their dreams.

The fund awards students for their effort and commitment to their studies in spite of any personal challenges.

**There are currently four \$600 student awards available to students enrolled in Aurora College's Adult Literacy and Basic Education program and who are residents of the Beaufort-Delta or Sahtu regions.**

**Recipients of the student award who continue their studies in winter 2025 will be eligible for a second award of \$600 at the end of their 2025 winter semester.**

## Eligibility

### Eligible applicants must be:

- A student enrolled in two or more courses in the Aurora College Adult Literacy and Basic Education (ALBE) or Developmental Studies program. Student may not receive this award more than twice.
- Applicants not in receipt of student financial assistance from NWT SFA, ISETS or other sources will receive priority.
- Physically residing in an Aurora Campus community in the Beaufort or Sahtu region for 12 continuous months or more.
